

CLEANING WINDOWS & OTHER GLASS SURFACES

****IMPORTANT-** Be sure the glass is free of all dust and/or stucco residue before wiping
AND

*That the towel you are using is clean without dirt or detergents***

Removing water/mineral buildup on glass

****IMPORTANT-** do not use this process on tinted or plastic type surfaces– it may scratch AND
Be extra careful when using around any natural stone. Ingredients may etch if it gets on
polished natural stone



We offer two methods for this type of cleaning problem

1: Scum&Scale Remover w/ steel wool 000 or 3M white pad

Begin by putting the Scum&Scale on the glass surface with a sponge or white pad. Allow to sit for 5+ minutes without drying. Agitate in circular motions with the white pad or steel wool pad. Rinse and repeat if necessary. Once free of mineral deposits, follow regular glass cleaning procedure described below.



2: It Works Glass Cleaner w/ steel wool 000 or 3M white pad

Wet surface to be cleaned with clear water. Sprinkle It Works onto dampened steel wool or white pad. Rub in a circular motion until surface is smooth. Repeat if necessary. Rinse w/ clear water. Follow regular glass cleaning procedure described below.

If cleaning a surface with an excessive amount of mineral buildup, use the Scum&Scale first, let it set for a couple of minutes, sprinkle It Works on dampened steel wool or white pad and follow remaining steps in #2.



Cleaning windows with a squeegee and scrub wand



1: Fill bucket with water before adding concentrated soap-

- 2: Dip scrub wand into bucket and wring out excess liquid.
- 3: Scrub window using large circular strokes. Don't apply more solution than needed to wash. If you need to scrape off paint, stucco, etc. be sure to keep surface wet when using the scraper. Scrape around the perimeter. Then using long strokes, scrape towards center. Only scrape forward, lifting scraper off glass after each stroke.
- 4: After scraping window clean, repeat step 2 and scrub window using large circular strokes.
- 5: Using a squeegee- *Horizontal strokes:* To create a dry edge, tilt the squeegee so that 1 to 2 inches of the channel touches the glass and pull down the side of the window. *Vertical strokes:* Tilt squeegee and place 1 to 2 inches on glass and pull across the top of the window creating a dry edge.
- 6: Start on dry edge area and pull squeegee across (or down if vertically cleaning) glass to frame on opposite side. Use overlapping strokes and wipe squeegee blade with lint free cloth after each stroke.
- 7: Be sure top of squeegee is tilted to right so that the water runs to bottom of the window.
- 8: Finish by wiping frame with a lint free cloth.

Cleaning windows by spraying on & wiping off

- 1: It is very important to use clean, soap free, lint free towels.- Microfiber towels are great.
- 2: Lightly dust surface with a dry microfiber towel being careful not to scratch.
- 3: Take your ready to use glass cleaner– *Clear Reflections/ Misty Concentrate (diluted in spray bottle)* and spray area to be cleaned and immediately wipe with dry towel
- 4: Dry polish with a clean, lint free cloth.
